



Covid-19 Policy

Natural Medicine of Stillwater offers complementary and alternative medicine in an integrative and holistic approach. Our clinic offers a multi-disciplinary staff that includes 2 naturopaths, a chiropractor and a medical doctor.

Natural Medicine of Stillwater has remained open throughout the COVID-19 crisis and are committed to remaining open for the foreseeable future.

In order to protect our clients and staff from COVID-19, the clinic has updated its policies and practices:

Patient COVID-19 Policy

- Masks are mandatory in our building and must be worn properly.*
- Wash/ sanitize hands before and after leaving our clinic.
- Temperature check.
- Maintain social distancing of 6 ft at all times.
- Do not handle any nutritional dispensary shelf item.
- If you believe you have been exposed to COVID-19, please postpone office visits until you have been medically cleared of exposure.
- If you are experiencing symptoms of COVID19 (fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, loss of smell), please do not come to clinic. Call to talk to a doctor or reschedule your appointment.

Office COVID-19 Policy

- Rooms are sterilized between appointments.
- Entire clinic is sterilized at the conclusion of each day.
- Hand-held items (pens, cups, clip boards, etc.) are cleaned between uses.
- Curbside pickup and drop off for nutritional supplements and at-home laboratory collection boxes is available.
- Limited number of appointments daily to allow for social distancing.
- Free Shipping with every nutritional supplement order.
